

Bradford History Travel Fund and Julian Saunders Memorial Travelling Bursaries for undergraduates

The Department of History at Manchester is fortunate to be able to offer support for students to travel to conduct research related to their dissertations. The department hopes to make a number of awards of between £50 and £300. Applications will be judged in relation to their contribution to the successful completion of the research project.

The Bradford History Scholarship was set up in 1877 by Miss Mary Bradford of Higher Broughton in Lancaster in memory of her late brother, William. Funds are available from this generous gift to assist third-year undergraduate students in history with travel to support their dissertation research.

The Julian Saunders Memorial Travelling Bursaries were established in 1993 by a generous donation from the family of Julian Saunders who died in 1991 at the age of 38. The bursaries are intended as a lasting tribute to a student of history who benefitted enormously from the opportunity to travel. The bursaries offer a fitting memorial to Julian by extending that opportunity to future generations of Manchester history students which Julian himself had so valued.

These two funds can be used to support both travel and accommodation for students to support research for their BA dissertations: for example to consult archives, conduct interviews or visit historic sites. All applications to the funds must be made using the attached form and you are advised to ask your supervisor to check your application before you submit. Unfortunately, due to the strict time constraints, late applications cannot usually be considered.
