




HERITAGE VALUE OF BUILDINGS

- All three buildings are Grade II Listed and linked together
- Coupland 3 was built by Alfred Waterhouse in 3 phases between 1875 and 1894 for use as a medical school
- Pharmacy Building was built by Alfred Waterhouse in 1895 and then extended by his son - Paul Waterhouse - in 1904
- Schunck Building was originally built in Salford in 1871 but was then relocated to its current location by Paul Waterhouse in 1904

CONSTRAINTS AND OPPORTUNITIES

- All three buildings are Grade II Listed
 - Largely designed to be open plan with plenty of natural daylight
 - Alterations are constrained by existing structure and location of windows
 - Opportunity to re-provide the fantastic large and vaulted spaces that have been lost over the years through alterations and additions
 - Room sizes have largely been dictated by the building
- English Heritage & Planning Approval
 - Proposals dependant of English Heritage approval
 - Consultation already underway


PROPOSED ENTRANCE BURLINGTON STREET


































POST GRADUATE RESEARCH CENTRE (QUIET SPACE) SCHUNCK BUILDING
