Add on	What does this do?
Detachable keyboard	Provides you with a physical keyboard that is more comfortable for typing
Memory card slot	Allows you to import photos taken with a digital camera from a memory card
Data plan	Allows you to remain connected where wi-fi is not available
Stylus	Allows you to draw or sketch directly onto your screen (using a compatible app)
VGA adapter	Allows you to connect your device to a large screen for presentations
Larger capacity version	A 32GB or 64GB version(as opposed to the standard 16GB version) will be more suited to storing lots of large files e.g. high resolution photos
iTunes vouchers	Essential if you wish to purchase additional apps or content without registering a credit card
Additional Lightning cable/charger	A spare computer transfer cable or mains charger (both can be used to charge the device)
AppleCare+	AppleCare is an extended warranty which provides up to 2 years of additional hardware coverage for your device including up to two incidents of accidental damage
