You may like to consider...

Add on	What does this do?
Stylus	Allows you to draw or sketch directly onto your screen (using a compatible app)
Data plan	Allows you to remain connected where wi-fi is not available
VGA adapter	Allows you to connect your device to a large screen for presentations
Larger capacity version	A 32GB or 64GB version(as opposed to the standard 16GB version) will be more suited to storing lots of large files e.g. high resolution photos
Additional data transfer cable	A spare cable to connect the device to your computer (can also be used for charging with some devices)
Additional charger	A spare mains charger (comes with USB cable to connect the device to your computer)
Mini notebook mouse	A compact, wired or wireless mouse can be connected to Surface tablets.
Microsoft Type Cover keyboard	A keyboard/cover to replace the touch sensitive keyboard which makes typing easier and more accurate.
USB Hub	For connecting more than one USB accessory at once
