PLEASE NOTE:

When selecting your course units you must ensure you take:

- 120 credits overall (including any core course units)
- Minimum of 50 credits per semester
- Maximum of 70 credits per semester
- You can take maximum 20 credits at Level 1.
- As a joint honours student, you must ensure that you take a minimum of 40 and a maximum of 80 credits in each subject. If you choose to take 40 credits in one subject of your Joint Honours programme, you must take a minimum of 60 credits in the other subject.
- We would encourage you to discuss your course unit options with your Academic Adviser.
- We would advise you to check timetable details for units you choose to ensure that you do not have any clashes!

• The semester a unit is taught in is identified by the last digit in the course code: e.g. CLAH30220. A '0' identifies the course unit is taught over both semesters, a '1' indicates Semester 1, and '2' indicates Semester 2
