### Get-on Get-off bus

A free shuttle bus service running from the University campuses to Manchester city centre and back again.

With 5 stops en route; Brunswick Street, St Peter's Square, Deansgate (near John Rylands Library), Piccadilly Gardens and Sackville Street, you will soon know Manchester like the back of your hand! If you get lost then don't panic, there will be Student Ambassadors at each stop to point you in the right direction. This is a ticketless service running regularly throughout the day and there may be queues during busy times. The last bus arrives back at Brunswick Street at 5pm.


