Fire Safety/Personal Safety Talk

There is a compulsory talk on **Sunday, September 14th at 4pm** in the main hall (the entrance to the hall is opposite Owens Park Reception – use the stairs to go up to floor 1). The talk will cover some important information about how to stay safe and well in Manchester.

The Pastoral Team

We will help you to join the hall community as soon as you arrive and continue to support your welfare throughout the year. We consist of a Warden (Martine Storey), Deputy Warden (Andrew Abu-Muharib) and nine Pastoral Tutors (Amile, Dean, Fiona, Jack, James, Mark, Samina, Tim and Will) The Pastoral Team are all members of university staff or postgraduate students. We are here to provide support and advice with any issues that you encounter in coming to study and live in Manchester.

A Tutor is allocated to each block and he/she will meet with you during Welcome Week to have a chat about how the hall works and answer any questions that you have. A Duty Tutor is on call every night and all day and night at the weekends to help with emergencies (look at the posters in your flat for further details). **It is really important that you get in touch with us if you have any problems- we can provide advice or let you know about other support services that can help.**


Enjoy Welcome Week and I wish you every success for the year ahead.
