Core Technology Facility



This venue houses a variety of contemporary meeting spaces on the Oxford Road Campus, from a boardroom for 8 up to 120 delegates theatre style. It is a great choice for interviews, meetings, conferences and training events.

Oddfellows Hall



This Grade II listed building has been sympathetically restored whilst offering modern meeting spaces. The rooms are ideal for interviews, away days, training events and smaller conferences. The Beehive Restaurant offers seated dining for 80 and receptions for 175, with more informal catering spaces for 20 to 50.

Whitworth Art Gallery



Overlooking Whitworth Park, the Gallery offers a mixture of historic and contemporary event spaces. These include the Jacobean-styled Grand Hall available for larger daytime meetings, the South Gallery, Upper Promenade and glass sided Whitworth Café, with views across the park, for evening hospitality and formal dining.

Manchester Museum



A unique cultural venue with several stunning galleries for dinners up to 120 and receptions for 300 guests. Choose from the Victorian Living Worlds Gallery, the impressive Fossils Gallery with full sized replica T-Rex, and the Main Hall, the latest addition to the meeting and hospitality spaces. The second floor offers year round meeting space, the Conference Room with hybrid facilities and the Kanaris Theatre and Foyer for numbers up to 90.

Based in the old Science Library, and one of the University's hidden gems, Christie's offers a relaxing place for daytime hospitality. 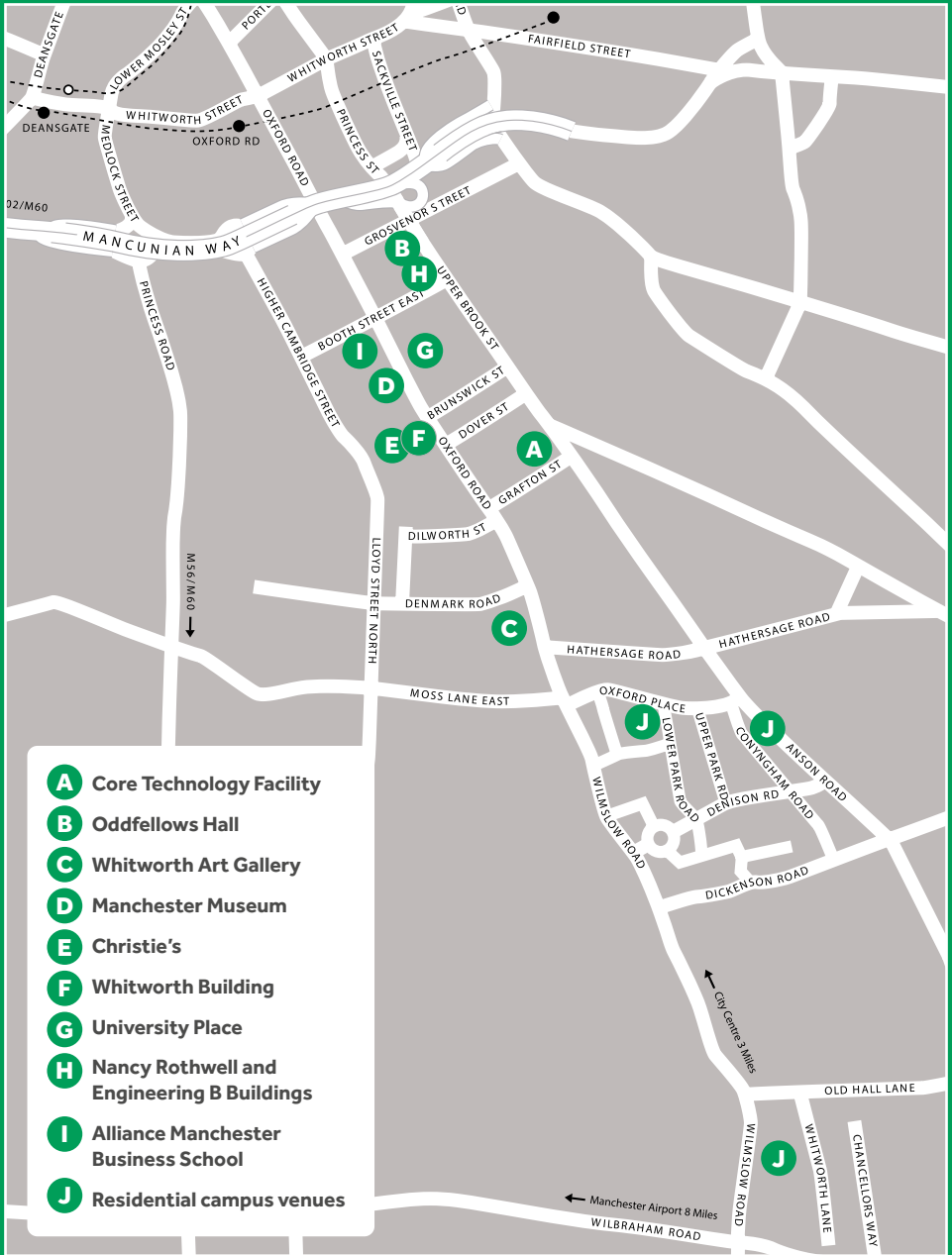
