WHAT DOES THE UNION DO?
 The University of Manchester Students' Union is a student-led organization established in 1906 which represents all students at the University of Manchester. We are a registered charity with a turnover in excess of £6.5 million per year. The Students' Union is at the heart of student life which encompasses representation, welfare, clubs and societies, volunteering and training, along with our commercial activities.

HOW WE ARE FUNDED
 Every year the University gives us a block grant of around £2.2 million. This helps support our work in representing students, advising you when things are difficult and providing over 200 societies, clubs and sporting events. The rest of the money needed to run the Union is generated by our shops, cafe, bars and Academy Venues. Every penny you spend in our outlets goes into improving our services and support for you. We also work with other carefully selected partners to bring money in from businesses and fundraising by students, which will be donated to the great causes.

THE EXEC TEAM
 The Students' Union is a charitable organization with eight full-time officers who are elected as Executive Officers and Trustees. The Board of Trustees is made up of the eight Executive Officers, three students and two non-student trustees. The Board of Trustees is responsible for the overall governance of the Union, while the Executive Officers are responsible for implementing the day-to-day running of the organization.

Education Officer
 I am responsible for the academic interests of the student body. I work with the University to ensure that the quality of education is high and that students have the best possible learning experience.

Diversity Officer


Q How many permanent staff does the Students' Union employ? ?
