PLEASE NOTE:

When selecting your course units you must ensure you take:

- ✓ 120 credits overall (including any compulsory courses)
- ✓ Minimum of 50 credits per semester
- ✓ Maximum of 70 credits per semester
- ✓ Minimum 100 credits must be Level 2
- ✓ Maximum 20 credits at Level 1
- ✓ 4 courses **MUST** be CLAH-coded courses

HELPFUL HINTS:

- ✓ The semester a course is taught in is identified by the last digit in the course code e.g. CLAH30220. A '0' identifies the course unit is taught over both semesters, a '1' indicates Semester 1 and '2' indicates Semester 2.
- ✓ To enrol on any of the course units outlined in your programme structure use the Self Service area of Campus Solutions.
