



View 2 - View from Chancellors Way entrance



The Works

Led by The University of Manchester, The Works is a one stop shop supporting local people to find jobs, develop skills and access training.

- Creating real opportunities, on and off campus, for local unemployed people
- In 2015 ran training academies including construction, barista, hospitality, domestic attendant and building attendant
- 3,400 people helped into employment since 2011
- 2,500 people helped to access training and development since 2011
- 129 people trained and employed at The University of Manchester in the last three months
