

Humanities RSS Major Funding Briefing: The Leverhulme Trust

REMIT AND SCOPE

Majority of funding is made via responsive modes. The Trust's primary aim is to fund "original research that advances knowledge of the world and ourselves". The Trust does not usually set strategic priorities or themes and funding decisions made on the bases of quality, significance, and originality of the proposed research.

FUNDING CRITERIA

Prioritising outstanding scholarship

- Originality: more than the incremental development of a single discipline
- Importance: will enable further research or enquiry
- Significance: relevance outside the field
- Merit: quality of research design, methodology, suitability of researchers and institution.

The Trust values

- Individual's personal vision, aspiration or intellectual curiosity
- Appropriate risks
- Departure from established patterns of working
- Transcend disciplinary boundaries.
