

JustFest Short Film Competition Rules and Tips

Rules

Want to enter the JustFest Short Film Competition? Here's what you need to know.

1. Make a short film on an issue of social justice
2. Films must be between 30 and 90 seconds in length
3. You can submit an entry as an individual or as a group. Your group can be any size you like, but remember the more people you have in your group will mean greater sharing of the prizes!
4. You can only enter the competition once, either as an individual or as part of a group
5. Upload your short film to YouTube or Vimeo and complete the online application form
6. The deadline for entries is Sunday 28th February at 23:59 – films entered after this date will not be considered
7. Voting for the People's Choice Award opens at 4pm on Monday 29th February and closes lunchtime on Tuesday 8th March
8. Films must be your independent work and comply with the University of Manchester regulations
9. The competition is only open to University of Manchester undergraduate students
10. Winning entries will be announced as part of JustFest on 9 March 2016
