# THE FINAL YEAR

In the final year, students write a **40 credit dissertation**, and choose a further 80 credits from the list of available options. In order to keep the balance correct, two options must be taken in the first semester and two options in the second.

# **STUDENTS WHO STUDIED ABROAD IN SECOND SEMESTER LAST YEAR**

Students who studied abroad in the second semester of their second year will need to take the following full year courses:

- **Dissertation (40 credits)**
- **Arguing with Anthropology (20 credits)**

They then choose three final year options, at least one in each semester, and the third can be in either semester.
