Free Choice Units

- Up to 20 units
 - Manchester Leadership Programme (take in second year)
 - Languages (LEAP)
- See “Free Choice Course Units” in booklet p.20-21
- Register Online from mid-July

Don't put off doing free choice units until the final year - we are much stricter in granting permission in the final year.

Level 1 Course Units

- Normally: Up to 20 credits of course units listed in the second year programme structure OR free choice courses
- Exceptionally: more than 20 credits with permission of the programme director or programme tutors

- TOTAL CREDIT RATING OF 120
- MAXIMUM OF 80 CREDITS FROM ANY ONE PATHWAY
- A MINIMUM OF 50 CREDITS AND A MAXIMUM OF 70 CREDITS IN EACH SEMESTER.

- NOTE SECOND YEAR COMPULSORY AND CORE COURSE UNITS
- NOTE PREREQUISITES FOR THIRD YEAR PATHWAYS
- NOTE PREREQUISITES FOR INDIVIDUAL COURSES
 - especially for FINAL YEAR COMPULSORY OR CORE COURSE UNITS

KEEP YOUR OPTIONS OPEN

SATISFY REQUIREMENTS FOR AT LEAST TWO PATHWAYS

REGISTRATION

- Pre - Register online via My Manchester Student Portal from mid July (but not for courses that have prerequisites in which you have resits) – p.24
- Academic and Financial Registration beginning of September – p.27.

Examinations

- FIRST YEAR MARKS DO NOT COUNT TOWARDS THE FINAL DEGREE CLASSIFICATION
- PASS OR FAIL EXAM AS A WHOLE

EXAM CONVENTIONS

To pass the exam as a whole you need:

- Passes in courses totalling 80 credits
– pass mark is 40%
- A minimum of 30% in any failed course.
- Failed courses can be compensated.
- Compulsory course units cannot be compensated
- See p.6 (under progression)

Resits in August

22nd August – 2nd September

Keep this period free!

After Resits:

Students who have not passed the year as a whole

Carry 10 or 20 credits

Passed 100 or 110 credits
