# Other Courses

- Free Choice Courses
  - Maximum of 20 credits
  - Normally if continuation of second year course
  - See booklet for websites and offices for further information - p.20 and 21
  - Check registration dates and procedures p.24
- Second Level course units
  - Up to 20 credits as specified in schedules or free choice

Total Credits Rating Of 120 for Honours

Minimum of 50 Credits and Maximum of 70 Credits in  
Each Semester

## Single Honours

- At Least 80 Credits in one pathway

## Joint Honours

- At Least 50 Credits from both pathways

- Note Compulsory and Core Courses for pathways
- Compulsory course units = must be taken and passed to satisfy pathway requirement(s)
- Core = must be taken to satisfy the pathway requirement(s)
- Note Individual Course Prerequisites

# Registration

## Pre – Register:

- online via My Manchester Student Portal from mid July (but not for courses that have prerequisites in which you have resits) – p.24

## Academic and Financial Registration:

- beginning of September – p.27.

# EXAM CONVENTIONS

To pass the exam as a whole you need:

- Passes in courses totalling 80 credits – pass mark is 40%
- A minimum of 30% in any failed course.
- Failed courses can be compensated.
- Compulsory course units cannot be compensated
- See p.12 (under progression)

## Second Year Marks Count Towards Final Degree Classification

- The average mark is weighted as 33 % of the final degree classification
- Based on your first attempt!!
