20 or 40 credit dissertation (core):

Either a 20 OR 40 credit dissertation (core):		
SOCY30920	Dissertation A	20
SOCY30930	Dissertation B	40

Plus:

- **100 credits (if selecting SOCY30920) of sociology options**
- **Or 80 credits (if selecting SOCY30930) of sociology options**
- You should balance your workload fairly evenly between the two semesters (i.e. 60 credits per semester). If doing more credits in one semester than the other, then think about having the bigger workload in semester 1 so you have more time for finishing your dissertation in semester 2.
- **Total: 120 credits**
