You must be registered for 120 credits exactly. A minimum of 50 credits or a maximum of 70 credits can be taken in one semester. The credits for a full year unit are weighted evenly across both semesters.

Step 2a – Optional Course Units

SPECIAL PERMISSION TO UNDERTAKE LANGUAGE UNITS

With special permission from the Programme Director, students may be able to choose up to 40 credits in Chinese, Japanese or Korean language, of which 20 credits may be included in the 100 credits of the named subject areas of the degree (any further credits would be counted as free choice). If, however, students wish to take 40 credits in language units, they must include course units in two different languages (40 credits in the same language are not allowed, with the exception that CHIN28572 may be taken alongside another Chinese language course unit, provided the prerequisites for CHIN28572 are met). In this case, the course units can either be two LEAP units in different languages, or one LEAP unit and one degree course unit in different languages. This will be on the condition that students are a second-language learner of the chosen language and students will be assessed by the relevant instructor.

Step 2b: Optional Course Units

If you have taken 20 or more credits in language units as part of Step 2a, then you must enrol on to a minimum of 60 credits from the following course units in LIST A, with at least 20 credits in Chinese (CHIN-coded course units and HIST20422) and Japanese (JAPA-coded course units). If you have not taken 20 or more credits in language units as part of Step 2a, then you must enrol on to a minimum of 80 credits from the following course units in LIST A, with at least 20 credits in both Chinese (CHIN-coded course units and HIST20422) and Japanese (JAPA-coded course units). Please note that within the 120 credits for the year, a maximum of 20 credits can be taken at Level 1 (course code starting 1).
