**Step 1:** Please ensure that you have read and understood the accompanying guidance document here:

You must be registered for 120 credits exactly. A minimum of 50 credits or a maximum of 70 credits can be taken in one semester. The credits for a full year unit are weighted evenly across both semesters.

As a joint-honours student, you must ensure that if you take 40 credits in one subject of your Joint Honours programme, then you must take a minimum of 60 credits in the other subject. Politics and French students must always do a minimum of 60 credits on the Politics side.
