PLEASE NOTE:

When selecting your course units you must ensure you take:

- 120 credits overall (including any compulsory courses)
- Minimum of 50 credits per semester
- Maximum of 70 credits per semester
- 120 credits must be Level 1
- Joint Hons students may take up to a maximum of 20 credits (free choice) outside of the two named subject areas, subject to approval by the relevant Programme Director

HELPFUL HINT:

- ✓ The semester a course is taught in is identified by the last digit in the course code. E.G. AHVS30000. A '0' identifies the course unit is taught over both semesters, a '1' indicates Semester 1 and '2' indicates Semester 2
- ✓ To enrol on any of the course units outlined in your programme structure use the Self Service area of Campus Solutions

2: Minor or Free Choice Units

As a single honours student you have the option to study a [Minor](#) subject alongside your single honours Major subject.

Alternatively, in discussion with your Academic Advisor, you must choose at least 20 credits of free choice from across the School of Arts, Languages and Cultures, or 20 credits from elsewhere in the University.

Please note that subject combinations are subject to availability and timetabling constraints.

2a: Choosing a Minor

Please select the relevant course units for the Minor, ensuring that you choose all 40 credits.

2b: Choosing Free Choice

Alternatively, in discussion with your Academic Advisor, if you do not take a Minor, you must choose at least 20 credits of Free Choice units and a maximum of 40 credits. No more than 20 credits per year can be taken outside of the School of Arts, Languages and Cultures; therefore at least 20 credits of your free choice must be pre-fixed by one of the following course unit codes (you cannot take more than 20 credits free choice from the **same** subject area, with the exception of SALC/LALC) Applicable course units include those with the following prefixes:

AHVS; AMER; ARGY; CHIN; CLAH; DRAM; ENGL; FREN; GERM; HIST; ITAL; JAPA; LALC; LELA; MEST; MUSC; REES; RELT; SALC; SPLA

A further 20 credits can be taken from another subject area in the School of Arts Languages and Cultures, or from elsewhere in the University. No more than 20 credits of Free Choice units per year may be taken outside of the School of Arts, Languages and Cultures.
