Please note when choosing the course units, you wish to take you must ensure you choose:

- a minimum of 50 credits per semester
- a maximum of 70 credits per semester
- 120 credits overall (including any compulsory courses)
- no more or no less credits as stated from each list

Helpful hints:

- Course codes ending in '1' are taught in the first semester, those ending in '2' are taught in the second semester, and those ending in '0' are taught over both semesters
- Please check the timetable for courses you choose to ensure that you do not have any clashes

Step 3: Choosing Free Choice

Alternatively, in discussion with your Academic Advisor, you may choose Free Choice units from more than one subject. No more than 20 credits per year can be taken outside of the School of Arts, Languages and Cultures; therefore at least 20 credits of your free choice must be pre-fixed by one of the following course unit codes (you cannot take more than 20 credits free choice from the **same** subject area, with the exception of SALC):

CHIN; CAHE; DRAM; ENGL; FREN; GERM; HIST; ITAL; JAPA; LELA; MEST; MUSC; RUSS; RELT; SALC; SPLA

A further 20 credits can be taken from another subject area in the School of Arts Languages and Cultures, or from elsewhere in the University, e.g. UCIL. No more than 20 credits of Free Choice units per year may be taken outside of the School of Arts, Languages and Cultures.

NB: A course unit is only free-choice if it is listed as such in the course in My Manchester.

As a single honours student in SALC you have the option to study the minor in **Digital Humanities**. Taking this minor allows you to explore the subject area, whilst still allowing you to complete your single honours degree. At the end of the first year, you can choose to continue with the minor in years two and three, and have the subject feature in your degree title if you wish. Alternatively, if you decide to drop the minor, you can still make use of free choice credits in years two and three.
