<p>Opera North is engaged in a three year project exploring the relationships between Violence and Performance; how violent acts are represented in opera and theatre, and how real-world violence is informed or influenced by ideas of staging and spectacle. As part of the project Opera North is interested in <i>the use of music as an act of violence itself – for example the use of thrash metal in prison camps in Iraq, and evidence of music being used for torture or in psychological conflict. Another area of interest is the composition of music deliberately designed to challenge, disorientate or otherwise upset the listener/spectator.</i></p> <p>Connections – the Performing Violence research project includes leading academics from the Universities of Leeds and Bristol. Other arts organisations are also involved. This network may be helpful for the placement and may help to increase the circulation/impact of the research.</p>
