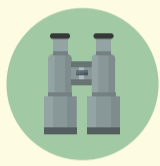




Introducing Pathways

University of Manchester eProg Summary

A pathway is a mode of study for an individual degree programme and requires basic information including title, intake period, year, study mode and faculty. Further details such as programmes, milestones, skills training, taught units, forms and timelines need to be added in separately.



Search for an existing pathway

Enter eProg management and select 'Manage Pathways'. Search in keywords for an existing pathway. Click 'Find'. If you need more results, click 'All' to increase the number.



Create a new pathway

If you cannot find an existing pathway, you can create a new one. Within manage pathways, click 'Add New Pathway'. Enter details of the pathway title and select the intake period, year, study mode, faculty and school. Click 'Save'. **Changes saved** indicates successful creation.



Amend a pathway

Once you are happy with the duplication, amend the pathway with the relevant details in the title box and select the intake period and year. Click 'Save'. **REMEMBER!** a duplicated pathway is pre-populated with content from the template pathway. This can be changed in the 'Manage Pathways' tab.



Duplicate a pathway

Duplicating a pathway is possible for degree programmes undertaken annually. Within Manage Pathways, click 'Add New Pathway'. Select 'Copy Existing Pathway'. Get more accurate results by filtering the pathway by year, faculty and school. Select the pathway you wish to duplicate.
