After completing your selection, you must ensure that you have chosen:

- a total of 120 credits
- a minimum of 100 credits at Level 1 or higher
- 40-60 credits in each named subject
- a minimum of 50 credits per semester
- a maximum of 70 credits per semester
- no more or no less credits as stated from each list

Helpful hints:

- ✓ All courses are 20 credits unless otherwise stated
- ✓ Course codes ending in '1' are taught in the first semester (sem 1), those ending in '2' are taught in the second semester (sem 2), and those ending in '0' are taught over both semesters (all year)
- ✓ Please check the timetable for courses you choose to ensure that you do not have any clashes
- ✓ IPML students have the chance to take a third language through the University Language Centre: <http://www.languagecentre.manchester.ac.uk/>. To take a third language you will be required to sacrifice 20 credits of optional course units from your named degree.
