

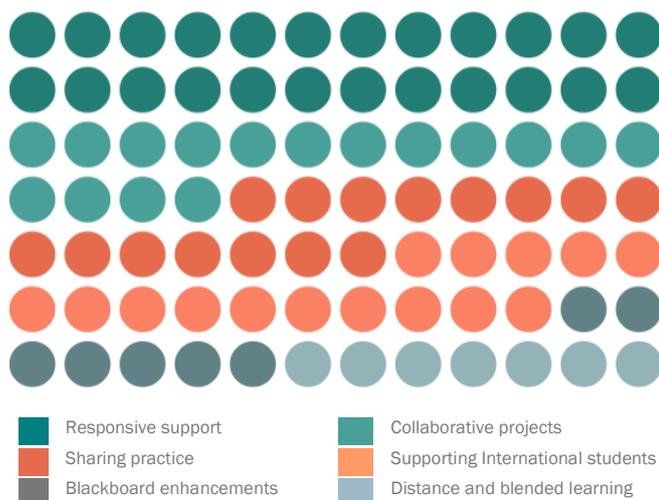
# SEED eLearning 2015-2017

## How we supported you in 2015-2016

### Training

We ran school-specific training sessions on Blackboard, Audio, TurningPoint, Turnitin, Grademark, and GoToMeeting.

# Top 5: Periodic Review

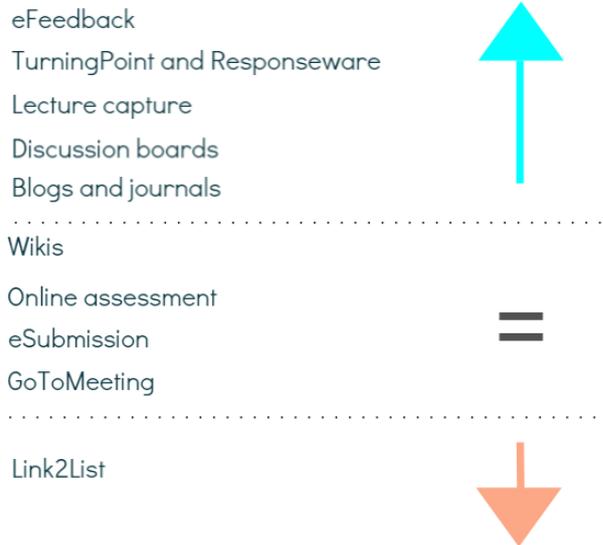
We were fortunate enough to be able to spend time reviewing over 20 course units/organisation spaces in depth this year as part of the Periodic Review. Successful practice we encountered included:

- #1 Making use of embedded video
- #2 Use of Twitter for course discussions
- #3 Blog tasks tied in with lecture discussions
- #4 Mid-semester knowledge checks using BB quiz tools
- #5 Using context and narrative to frame learning resources

## Online Tool Use

We review which tools are being used every year and whether usage increases or decreases. This helps us identify trends and areas where our support may be required.



### eSubmission and Marking Success

100% of courses that can utilise online assignment submission tools continued to do so this year. On top of this the percentage of course units making use of Grademark for providing online feedback increased from 62% to 88%.

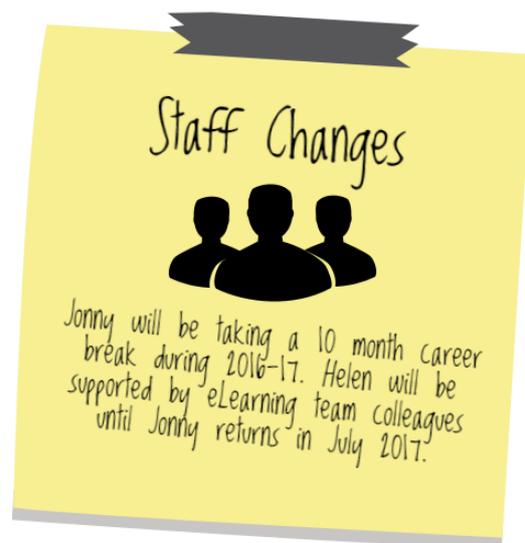
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
