PLEASE NOTE: After completing your selection, you must ensure that you have chosen:

- a total of 120 credits
- a minimum of 100 credits at Level 2 or higher
- a minimum of 50 credits per semester
- a maximum of 70 credits per semester
- no more or no less credits as stated from each list

Course unit enrolment checks are completed from start of teaching until the end of week two. Students who have not following the guidance within the programme structure could find that units they wish to take are no longer available.

3: Subject to the approval of the Programme Director and fulfilment of the steps above, including those from the other subject area of your degree programme, you may be permitted to take a maximum of 20 credits free choice if you have not reached the required 120 credits for the year. You can find the full list of free choice units from the Courses Tab within My Manchester login.manchester.ac.uk

PLEASE NOTE - when selecting your free choice course unit:

- For subject areas in the School of Arts, Languages and Cultures and University College (UCOL), the course unit must be at Level 1, 2 or 3, (please note that this does not include LEAP units, see below). Please note:
 - where a UCOL unit is a language unit (e.g. Arabic and Mandarin) the LEAP rules below apply.
 - if you have already chosen a Level 1 unit in one of the previous steps, you can only choose a Level 2 or 3 unit as free choice.
- For subject areas elsewhere in the University, the course unit must be at Level 2 or 3.
- LEAP course units –must be at Level 2 or 3 (provided that no more than three languages are studied in any one year) and must be applied for directly with the LEAP office. Your performance on this unit will be monitored, and you may be advised to discontinue with the study of the additional language in the subsequent year of study at the recommendation of your Academic Advisor or Programme Director.
 - Only the 10-credit LEAP Tandem course unit running in semester 1 is permitted in your own language of study in second year.
