## Terms and conditions – Visitor Parking

- 1. All bookings require a space to be reserved, so will be charged the booking fee whether or not the visitor(s) turn up.
- 2. Block bookings will be charged for the full number of spaces reserved, even if not all visitors turn up.
- 3. Bookings for Dilworth Street and/or North Campus will be processed on a first come first served basis. Once all available spaces have been reserved, bookings will be redirected to the nearest available multistorey car park.
- 4. Last minute bookings (received after 4pm the day before or on the same day) will **NOT** be processed.
- 5. Visitors who arrive on the day with no booking will have to pay for parking and, if required, obtain reimbursement from the department they are visiting.
- 6. Cancellation of any booking must be received **before** 4pm on the working day before the date of the booking; otherwise the full charge will be levied.
