## CALL The Tietgen Award

### Foundation and amount

In order to mark the centenary of C.F. Tietgen's birth on 19 March 1829, the Board of DSEB founded the Tietgen Award in 1929. Initially, the award took the form of a gold medal to be given each year in reward for the submission of an outstanding prize paper. The last prize paper was announced in 1978 and since then the Tietgen Award has been given for a substantial contribution to research.

Every year, DSEB grants the Tietgen Award of DKK 500,000 in recognition of a significant contribution to research in the field of business-oriented humanities and social science on the part of young researchers. If two applicants are considered equally eligible for the award, it can be shared.

All awards are accompanied by the Tietgen Gold Medal.

### The use of the award

The award is granted to fund study trips abroad or a research project administered by the recipient's university.

### Award criteria

The Tietgen Award addresses nascent research in Northern Europe and is therefore given to younger, up-and-coming researchers.

The Tietgen Award is granted to postdoctoral researchers, i.e. assistant professors and associate professors who have performed a maximum of five years of research since they acquired a PhD or similar degree.<sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup> In case of parental leave after the acquisition of the PhD degree, the number of incurred leave months will be deducted.

The award is granted on the basis of documented research, typically a publication in an internationally recognized, peer reviewed journal or a similar publication outlet”.

The award can also go to a group of researchers who have published or written a joint paper. In such cases, they share the award.

## **Candidates and recommendation procedure**

The Tietgen Award can be granted either on the recommendation of people at management level at education institutions, companies and organisations, etc., or it can be applied for. Individual applications must be accompanied by a recommendation from the applicant's closest supervisor.

This is an open call. There is a specific application form on DSEB’s website: <https://dseb.dk/tietgen-award-application> that should be used.

Applications should be no longer than six pages. Applications must document how the research in question lives up to the above-mentioned award criteria. A CV and a list of publications must be enclosed. There is also an option of enclosing a maximum of two selected publications.

Nominations are made on the basis of research performed and published in recent years. The research must have been undertaken or published during the period from January 1<sup>st</sup> 2015 to July 1<sup>st</sup> 2017.

The deadline for nominations is September 8<sup>th</sup> 2017.
