

MA Art Gallery and Museum Studies, – Part Time (2 years)

Course Structure

The AGMS MA is a modular degree with core and optional elements totalling to **180 credits**. Core and options courses combine to make 120 credits with the remaining 60 credits allocated to the dissertation. **Part time students take one core course and 30 credits of option courses per year. Part time students take the dissertation in Year 2.**
