After completing your selection, you must ensure that you have chosen:

- a total of 120 credits
- a minimum of 100 credits at Level 1 or higher
- a minimum of 50 credits per semester
- a maximum of 70 credits per semester
- no more or no less credits as stated from each list

Helpful hints:

- ✓ All courses are 20 credits unless otherwise stated
- ✓ Course codes ending in '1' are taught in the first semester, those ending in '2' are taught in the second semester, and those ending in '0' are taught over both semesters
- ✓ Please check the timetable for courses you choose to ensure that you do not have any clashes

Step 1: COMPULSORY COURSE UNITS (40 Credits)

You will automatically be enrolled for the courses in the following Compulsory List by your Programmes Administration Team:

Step 2: OPTIONAL COURSE UNITS (20 Credits)

You must choose a maximum of 20 credits from List B:

A level 1 course unit offered by History (HIST)		20 credits each
OR		
Two level 1 course units offered Economics (ECON)		10 credits each
*POLI10702 is a pre-requisite for the second-year course POLI20881 Freedom and Equality: Contemporary Debates

All Level 1 History courses except HIST10101, and SALC10002 are open to ESML students.

Students are advised to take particular note of the prerequisites for certain courses.

Note that you are not restricted to European languages when studying a second language, but you must only choose a language for which a suitable continuation course is available at Level 2.
