

Prevention of Smoking in Work

- 1. The University of Manchester Conferences Limited (UMC Ltd) ("the company") aims to provide a clean, comfortable and healthy environment for visitors, employees and students.
- 2. Under the provisions of the Health Act 2006 the company has a legal duty to ensure that the working environment is smoke-free and, as such, all work places and vehicles are designated as non-smoking.
- Guidance from the HSE is that the company is obliged to give priority to non-smokers who do not wish to breathe tobacco smoke; to this end, smokers will not be permitted to smoke within a five metre radius of the entrance to a building.
- **4.** For the purposes of this policy, electronic cigarettes ("e-Cigarettes") are included as if they were cigarettes.
- **5.** Disciplinary action may be taken in the event of contravention of this policy by employees or students.
- **6.** The company will provide assistance to those who wish to stop smoking through the University's Occupational Health Service and Counselling services.
