# Working as a student

## Things you should know:

- **Minimum wage**

Year	25 and over	21 to 24	18 to 20	Under 18	Apprentice
April 2017 (current rate)	£7.50	£7.05	£5.60	£4.05	£3.50

- **National Insurance number**

You will need to obtain a National Insurance number if you are going to work. Ring the National Insurance Contact Centre on 0345 6000 643 to apply for one






