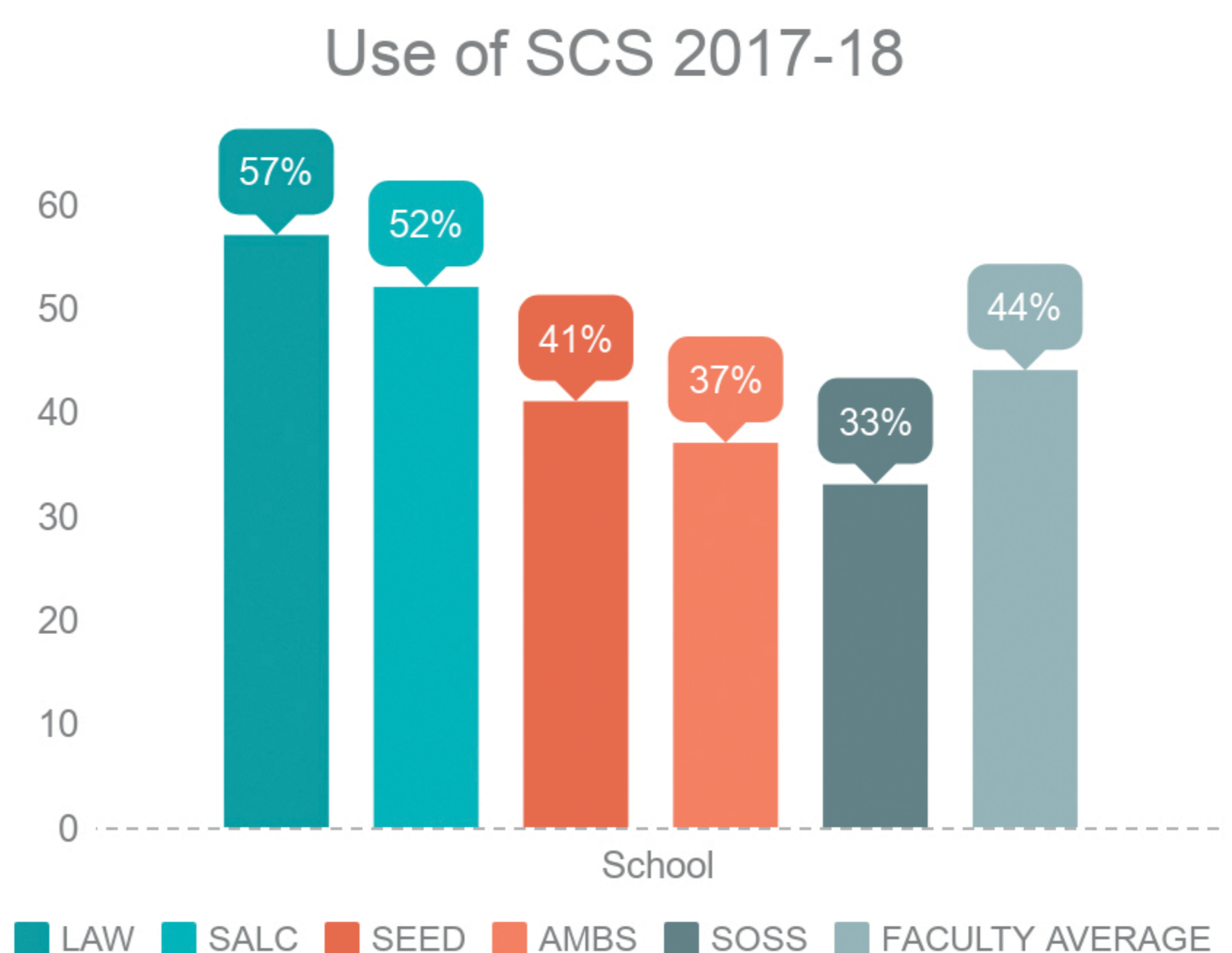


Use of SEED Standard Course Structure in Blackboard

Percentages of course units using SCS in 2017-18

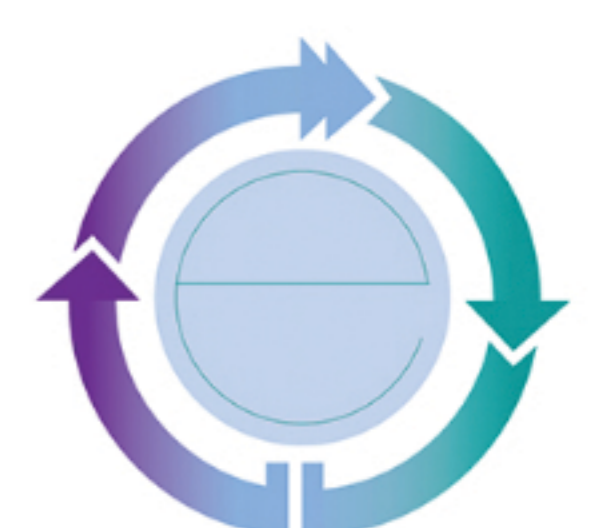
- LAW 57%
