

FBMH Teaching Opportunity: Recruitment for Personal Excellence Path (PEP) Report Moderators Year 2 PEP

The Personal Excellence Path (PEP) allows students to focus on particular topics during their medical degree, creating a personalised learning experience. These units may be within the field of medicine, or sit outside it in related areas such as ethics and law, humanities and applied social science.

In Year 2 students write a 10-15 page (1.5 line spacing) literature review.

Key Responsibilities and Resources:	 Read report, complete marking proforma and consider score of original marker Discuss scoring with supervisor, as appropriate There will be a tight deadline for moderating the reports to comply with University regulations.
Time Commitment/ Hours/ Dates:	 Up to 20 moderators to moderate 3-4 reports each (10-15 pages per report). Approx. 2-3 hrs per moderator. Must be available from 15 May to 30 May 2018 inclusive
Person Specification incl. Essential Knowledge Skills and Experience:	 Demonstrate an understanding of the undergraduate medicine MB ChB programme or equivalent Supervision of UG, PGT or PGR research dissertations Moderators may be current / previous PEP supervisors (but this is not a requirement)
Training and Support:	 Tutors will complete short online training for Year 2 PEP. Full explanation and marking criteria provided. Support provided by Year 2 PEP lead.
