### PLEASE NOTE:

When selecting your course units you must ensure you take:

- 120 credits overall (including any core courses);
- A minimum of 50 credits per semester;
- A maximum of 70 credits per semester;
- As a joint honours student, you must ensure that you take a minimum of 40 and a maximum of 80 credits in each subject (AHCP/HIST). If you choose to take 40 credits in one subject of your Joint Honours programme, you must take a minimum of 60 credits in the other subject.

### HELPFUL HINT:

- The semester a course is taught in is identified by the last digit in the course code. E.G. AHCP30000. A '0' identifies the course unit is taught over both semesters, a '1' indicates Semester 1 and '2' indicates Semester 2
