Step 2a: Students continuing with a Minor

Please note you cannot begin a new Minor in your second or third year of study.

Step 2b: Choosing Free Choice

Alternatively, in discussion with your Academic Advisor, you may choose Free Choice units from more than one subject. No more than 20 credits per year can be taken outside of the School of Arts, Languages and Cultures; therefore at least 20 credits of your free choice must be pre-fixed by one of the following course unit codes (you cannot take more than 20 credits free choice from the **same** subject area, with the exception of SALC):

CHIN; CAHE; DRAM; FREN; GERM; HIST; ITAL; JAPA; LELA; MEST; MUSC; RUSS; RELT; SALC; SPLA

A further 20 credits can be taken from another subject area in the School of Arts Languages and Cultures, or from elsewhere in the University, e.g. UCIL. No more than 20 credits of Free Choice units per year may be taken outside of the School of Arts, Languages and Cultures.
