

Contextual Offer alongside Access Programmes 2021 Cycle

Access Manchester Scheme	Differential offer for successfully completing programme	Conditions	Applicants flagged as WP Plus or who have been in care for more than three months and are eligible for a contextual offer. This is one A level grade below the standard offer.
Pathways to Law	1 A level grade (or equivalent) below the standard offer for the course.	Successfully complete Pathways to Law at any partner university. Applicable for firm and insurance course choice.	The Pathways to Law offer would be made in addition to the contextual data reduction. This means that a student who meets the WP Plus Flag criteria and completes the Pathways to Law programme would receive an offer of two A Level grades below the standard University of Manchester offer for their choice of course within the School of Law.
SoSS Pre-University Courses	1 A level grade below the standard offer for the course.	Successfully complete a SoSS pre-university course . Applicable for firm and insurance course choice.	The pre-university course offer would be made in addition to the contextual data reduction. This means that applicants who meet the WP plus flag criteria, chooses an undergraduate programme administered by the School of Social Sciences and successfully completes a pre-university course would receive an offer of two A level grades below the standard offer.
Preston Medicine Scheme	1 A level grade (or equivalent) below the standard offer for the course.	Successfully complete PWAP. Applicable for firm and insurance course choice.	Students who successfully complete PWAP will not be eligible for a contextual offer. The maximum reduction is one grade.
Manchester Access Programme (MAP)	2 A level grades (or equivalent) below the standard offer for the course.	Successfully complete MAP. Applicable for firm and insurance course choice.	Students who successfully complete MAP will not be eligible for a contextual offer as they already receive a lower offer of two A-level grades (or equivalent). Students who successfully complete MAP and have not received the lower offer of two A-level grades (e.g. a student on the General Strand of the programme who is only eligible for the standard offer for Medicine and Dentistry) will be eligible for the contextual data reduction if they are WP Plus flagged.
Manchester Distance Access Scheme (MDAS)	1 A level grade (or equivalent) below the standard offer for the course.	Successfully complete MDAS. Applicable for firm course choice only.	The MDAS offer would be made in addition to the contextual data reduction. This means that a student who meets the WP Plus Flag criteria, chooses Manchester as their firm choice and successfully completes MDAS would receive an offer of two A Level grades below the standard University of Manchester offer for their firm choice course. Applicants who choose Manchester as their insurance choice would not be eligible for MDAS and so would only receive a one grade contextual data reduction.
