

Crawford House Directions

The Division of Campus Life which coordinates some University disciplinary hearings is based in Crawford House. Disciplinary hearings will usually take place on the 3rd floor of Crawford House (31 on the map) in 3.004, Seminar Room 3. On occasions hearings may take place in 4.009b (the same directions as below apply, but just head one floor up).

The best way to reach Crawford House is via Booth Street East. There are multiple bus stops nearby, the closest being on Oxford Road next to the University's developing retail centre / old Precinct Centre. 'You can plan your journey via Transport for Greater Manchester [here](#).

To find the most appropriate, accessible entrance to Crawford House, turn off Oxford Road and head down Booth Street East, passing between Alliance Manchester Business School East (26) and Crawford House (31). Turn right off Booth Street East at the end of the building, just between Crawford House and the National Graphene Institute (90). Immediately turn right again and the accessible entrance will be directly ahead (see below).



Once inside Crawford House, there is a lift and set of stairs. You need to head to the third floor. Once outside the lift there is a waiting area next to a set of toilets. You will need to access the office corridor in front of you which is swipe card accessed. Please ring the doorbell and wait for someone to collect you and take you to the meeting room.
