



HALL LIFE


Our halls are secure, self-contained communities. Some have their own bars, common rooms and social activities.

ur accommodation is set across three main areas, all within easy reach of the campus, the city and amenities. Each area offers something different but all offer a great place to live and study.




Each dot represents one of our halls of residence

Fallowfield (9 sites)


A vibrant, mixed residential suburb, Fallowfield offers plenty of amenities. It's also within easy reach of the city centre.
