

# FBMH Teaching Allocation Process (19/20 teaching)

## Key Principles

No promises regarding changes to teaching load should be made during P&DR conversations.

Heads of Division should seek to ensure that there is fair contribution to teaching activity across all members of staff in line with their broader academic profile with the overall aim of maximising teaching capacity.

Individuals should meet the minimum expectations for teaching and supervision as set out in the [Faculty guidance](#).

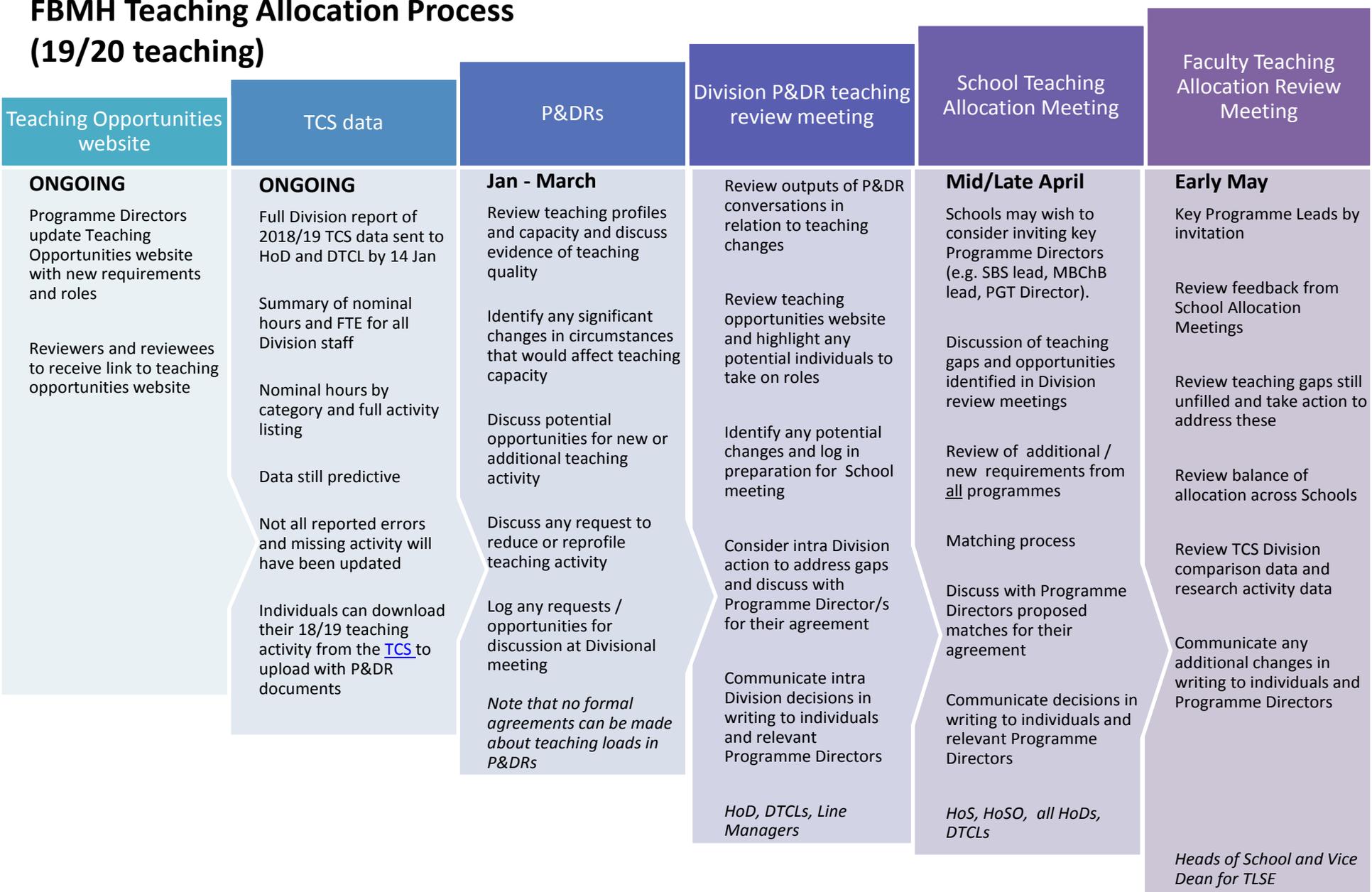
The expectation is that where a change in staffing creates a gap in teaching, the responsibility to identify a replacement will fall initially to the Division responsible for that individual and then to the School. Changes should be discussed and agreed with the relevant Programme Director/s.

New teaching roles or additional requirements will be logged on the [Faculty Teaching Opportunities website](#).

The communication of changes in circumstances (leavers, maternity, sabbaticals, etc.) and actions proposed to fill the resulting teaching gaps need to be coordinated by the Division with the relevant Programme Directors / Unit Leads.
