## Care experienced students/care leavers

### Halls of residence:

The University Accommodation Office can provide a flexible, up to **52 week accommodation** contract in University halls although this will not necessarily be at the same hall of residence for the full year as not all halls are open/available over the summer vacation. This can be for the duration of the student's programme of study if they wish.

#### Advantages:



- No need for a guarantor;
- No requirement for a deposit. This is not guaranteed but assessed on a case-to-case basis. Students should contact the Accommodation Office ([accommodation@manchester.ac.uk](mailto:accommodation@manchester.ac.uk)).
