# Year 5 Community placement

## What is it?

Year 5 students are making the transition from medical student to foundation doctor. They need to consider how they will manage patients, interact with staff and the public and make some firm career plans.

General Practice is an important career choice for students. This attachment with you offers them an excellent opportunity to address their learning needs and plan for their futures post-graduation.

## When?

All Year 5 students attend an eight week GP/ Acutely Ill block in either the first or second half of Semester 1.

In Semester 2 students may also opt for a 4 week block in GP.

## How much?

Payment is £2201.60 per student for 8 weeks , 2 days per week.

## What do I have to do?

You need to provide the student with opportunities to see patients:

- 3 clinical sessions running a supervised General Practice clinic

- 1 flexible clinical session

You will enable the Year 5 student to practice constructing management plans.

You will provide an induction, mid placement review and end of placement meeting. The Year 5 student will ask you and your colleagues to sign off their patient assessments, patient presentations and workplace-based assessments.
