



Accommodation

Estranged students

Halls of residence:

The University Accommodation Office can provide a flexible, up to **52 week accommodation** contract in University halls although this will not necessarily be at the same hall of residence for the full year as not all halls are open/available over the summer vacation.

Whilst this is not guaranteed to estranged students, it will be assessed on a case-to-case basis. Students should be encouraged to and supported in contacting the Accommodation Office to make them aware of their situation.

Advantages:



- No need for a guarantor;
- No requirement for a deposit. This is not guaranteed but assessed on a case-to-case basis. Students should contact the Accommodation Office (accommodation@manchester.ac.uk).
