Please note:

You have three core course units totalling 60 credits in your first year. You must choose 60 more credits of course units by following the steps outlined below. In total, you must take 120 credits across the full academic year.

When choosing the course units you wish to take, you must ensure that:

- you have a minimum of 50 credits in either semester;
- you have a maximum of 70 credits in either semester;
- you have only selected first year course units. You may **not** take any second or third year course units.
