


What to expect from your MAP Selection and Introduction Day



You will arrive at University Place, which is the building pictured above (students nickname this building the 'tin can').

The entrance is here



Once you enter University Place, the foyer looks like this:



There will be Student Ambassadors in the foyer guiding you up to the first floor, where you will register.

Student Ambassadors are current students of The University of Manchester who help us run MAP events. They will be dressed in purple:



Students should take the stairs, which are on the left as you enter the building, but if you have any accessibility needs, then there are lifts just next to the stairs.

Registers will be alphabetised by surname, but members of the MAP team and Student Ambassadors will make it clear on the day.

Once you have registered, you will be given a folder and a group number and will head in to the Lecture Theatre.

Lecture Theatre will look like this. Student Ambassadors will make sure that you know where you are going and sitting. There will be around 200 new students, so everyone is in the same position!



You will then receive a Welcome Talk from Sophie from the MAP team. There may also be other members of the MAP team who deliver some of the presentation.



Once the Welcome Talk is over, you will then go with your group and your two Student Ambassadors to your workshop rooms. There will be no more than 30 students in your group.

Your workshop rooms will look something like this, only with the tables set out in groups:



Male and female toilets can be found on every floor, and there is an accessible toilet on the ground floor. Make sure you just ask your designated Student Ambassador if you need to go.

Your Student Ambassadors will then explain the exact process of collecting in all your forms that you have brought along, as instructed in the email you received from the MAP team. If at any point you don't understand, please just ask an ambassador to explain again.

Once the Student Ambassadors have collected all your forms, they will then lead a Communications Workshop with you. This will last about 50 minutes.

Once this is over, you will come back to the Lecture Theatre to receive one last short talk from Mandy from the MAP team about the MAP Student Charter.

Once this is over, you will head back to the registration table to sign out.
