- You must be available to attend the first Museum Lates meeting on Tuesday 7th April, 3.30 – 5pm (this takes place straight after the first Launch Event).

- Your Museum Late will revolve around social action and giving young people a space to discuss and explore current issues. Which social action cause are you most passionate about and why? (Examples of social action causes may be mental health awareness, Extinction Rebellion or Refugee Action).
- Why do you think museums might not appeal to young people?
