We are unable to fulfil any orders for copies of academic transcripts due to the closure of non-essential facilities on the University campus. Therefore, this service has been suspended.

Please note that we are unable to provide access to a digital version of an academic transcript for:

- the following programmes: MBChB, BDS, PGCE, all undergraduate and taught postgraduate programmes in Architecture, all programmes undertaken in the School of Nursing, Midwifery and Social Work, and the Global MBA completed prior to July 2019.

- People who graduated prior to July 2000. In circumstances where a third party requires verification of an award they should be directed to www.hedd.ac.uk

The University does not provide academic transcripts for exchanges completed at another institution or for qualifications completed at an affiliated institution.
