Industrialisation - cloth production

Immigrants since Romans → cosmopolitan

- 16th Flemish weavers → wool
→ small centre textiles
- boom: Armenians, Irish, Jewish, Pakistan, India, E. Africa, Iran, Poland, Spain
- More Flemish weavers → Fustian = linen + cotton
→ wealth of Manchester = cotton ↑

1785+

- weave by hand (hand looms)
 - damp weather helps ≠ break up
 - 4,000 - 6,000 people
 - Industrialisation began → change agriculture → mass production society
 - Inventions = stronger thread = rapid (1764-1775)
= move from home → factories (mills)
 - Mills = long hours → no stopping
= child labour → clean under machines
→ injured
= hot + noisy → deafness
→ lung diseases
- } mule spinning factory
- population ↑ = 75,000 people
 - houses small
 - sewage → water → cholera
