Peterloo Mascare

- > cotton industry & Industrial revolution
 - = struggle working class ≠ vote
- 1809, 16,000 people = demonstration
 - = radicalists & :. army attacked (killing own people)
 - = 15 killed
 - = 600+ injured
- In St Peter's feel & ∴ called Peterloo Massacre

Manchester Town Hall

- 1877 (neo Gothic)
- mosaic floor flower cotton plant
 - bee = symbol of Manchester = ingenuity, hard work

Workers on strike

- no smoke from hills
- strike poor work. conditions & poor pay > civil unrest
- tradition in Manchester = Trade Union Congress (1868)
 - fight working conditions
 - education working class women
 - Mechanics Institute and foundation of UoM

Suffragette Movement

- 1913, Emmeline Pankhurst
- fight for women to vote

Abraham Lincoln Statue

- gift from the USA
- support Manch. people gave to abolition of slavery
- S. States = cotton workers ≠ cotton
 - ∴ Manchester ≠ cotton

- James Joule physicist & math.
- Alan Turing math. = computer science
- Nobel prize winner = UoM scientists
