I originally used [Ethnologue](#) to compile the data a couple of years ago – however, their data is now only available on a subscription basis

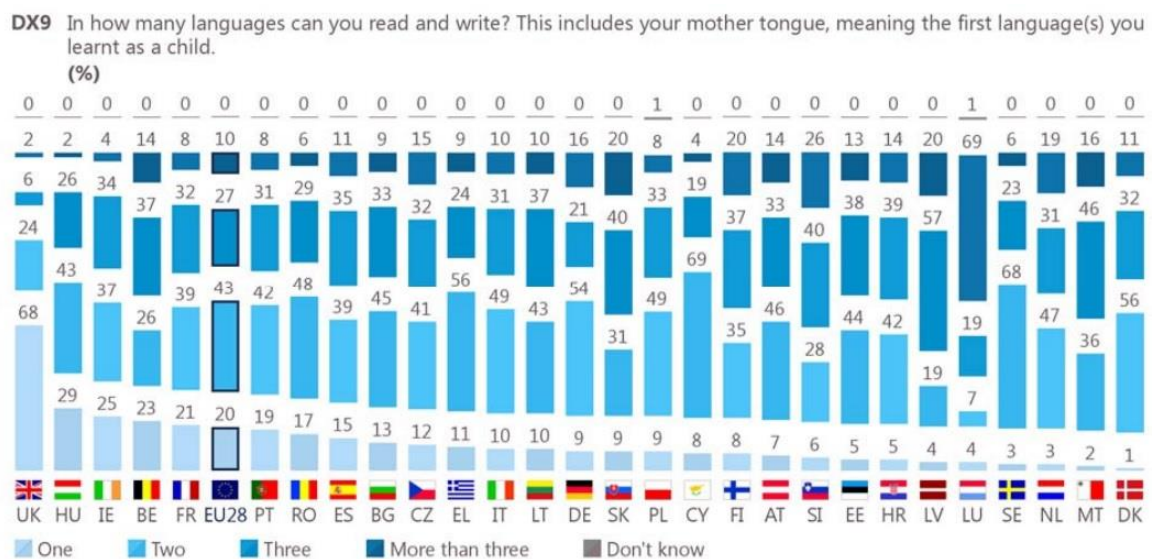
This [World Populations Review page](#) is useful and the [2013 British Council publication “The English Effect”](#) supports the data of 25% of the world’s population speaking English
